Recordbooks and Star Awards

Now is the time to start working on recordbooks. Recordbooks are a way for you to showcase your recordkeeping skills while highlighting your 4-H career. It is good for completing scholarship applications and for resumes. By doing a recordbook each year, you enable yourself to keep track of your entire 4-H career. Senior members can also earn a trip to Washington, D.C.

Along with recordbooks, comes the opportunity to win a Star Award. Star Awards include Rising (8-10 years old), Bronze (11-12 years old), Silver (13-14 years old), and Gold (15 and older). Gold Star Award recipients will receive a scholarship upon graduation. In addition, the "I Dare You" Award will be added back into the lineup for senior aged 4-H members. Recordbooks and Star Award Applications are due Monday, June 18th. Star Award Interviews will be Tuesday, July 17th at 9 am. Interview times will be given when the application is submitted.

4-H Enrollment for 2012-2013

As of September 1, 2011, all youth who register for 4-H membership will be assessed an annual participation fee. The enrollment process will once again begin in August. Please mark your calendar in preparation for the next year of 4-H opportunities.

The annual participation fee will be \$25.00. The early enrollment fee will be \$20.00 if done between August and October 31^{st} .

4-H Lamb and Goat Project Meeting

The Lamb and Goat project group will be holding it's first meeting of the year on Thursday, April 19, 2012, at the Extension Office in Bellville. The meeting will begin at 6:30 p.m. This month's program will include an update on fair rules, getting started with your lamb and goat project and animal selection. A breeder list, Fair Rule Book and 4-H project guide will be handed out at the program.

Livestock Project Group Drive-Thru Fundraiser

The Livestock Project Group helps to sponsor our 4-H animal project meetings during the spring and summer, culminating in the Showmanship contest in August. The group also provides money for paying entry fees for our 4-H youth to participate in the many judging events held throughout the year, such as payment of entry fees for livestock, consumer decision making and dairy judging contests. One of their annual fundraising activities is a drive thru dinner. This year, the drive thru dinner will take place on Sunday, April 22nd, 2012. Tickets are available from the Extension Office and from your project leader. Meal tickets are \$8.00, and orders must be turned in by Friday, April 13th, 2012.

Important Dates about Tag In and Validations for State and District Shows!!!

State Fair Lamb. Goat and Swine Validation

If you are planning on exhibiting a lamb, goat or swine project at the State Fair of Texas in Dallas on October 1-5, 2012, that animal will need to be validated. Tags are \$10.00 each and orders should be turned into the Extension Office by April 16th, 2012. State Fair animals will be validated on June 27th, 2012.

State Steer Validation

It's time once again to order steer validation tags for the major livestock shows. Validation of steers is required for anyone wanting to participate in the State Fair of Texas, Ft. Worth, San Antonio, Houston, Austin or San Angelo. Tags are \$10.00 each and orders should be turned in by April 16th, 2012. Steer validation will take place on June 27th, 2012.

Texas 4-H Horse Validation Program

Beginning with this year's Horse Validation Program, the process will now be all electronically completed using the 4-H CONNECT online management system. ALL 4-H members who wish to show in a district or the state 4-H Horse Show(s) will be required to validate their horse(s) on the 4-H CONNECT system.

VALIDATION WILL BE OPEN FROM APRIL 1, 2012 TO MAY 1, 2012. Any horse validated before or after this date will not be accepted as a legitimate validated animal. An illustrated step-by-step instruction guide for families is available for download and reference from both the Texas 4-H website and the Texas AgriLife Extension Animal Science - Horse Section website.

Validation cost for each horse will be \$10.00. Each 4-H family validating a horse(s) will need to print an invoice for each horse and provide the invoice(s) and check to the County Extension Office. There is no limit to the number of horses that can be validated in the process.

In the past, there was a Grade Horse worksheet that included the need for sketching markings and colors of horses. That form is no longer required, however, it is a requirement for ALL horses that photos of the front, left side, and right side are uploaded during the validation entry process. The entire horse MUST be in the photograph. Photos should be as close as possible and markings should be clearly visible. The photo should be in jpg or gif format.

A pdf or jpg of the registration papers will be uploaded for registered horses. If you do not have capabilities with scanning papers, contact the Extension Office we will assist you. More information can be found on the following web site; http://texas4-h.tamu.edu/horse_validation.

Austin County Fair Steer and Heifer Tag In is April 28th!

If you plan on exhibiting a halter heifer, market steer or a pen of two heifers at the Austin County Fair this year, then please mark Saturday, April 28th, 2012, on your calendar. That is the only tag in date available to persons wanting to participate in the show. Tag in will take place at Four County Livestock Auction in Industry from 7:00 - 10:00 a.m. There is a \$10.00 tag in fee per animal. Pen of Heifer exhibitors also will pay a \$50.00 pen nomination fee. Rule books are available from your project leader, the fair office, ag science teachers and the Extension Office.

Austin County Fair Broiler Orders Due May 11th!

Anyone interested in showing broilers at the Austin County Fair will need to order your birds by Friday, May 11th, 2012. The birds will cost \$1.55 per chick. Please make the checks payable to Austin County Fair, no cash will be accepted. Completed order forms need to be turned into the Extension Office. All broiler orders must be ordered in lots of 25 per exhibitor. A family may purchase and feed broiler chicks in the same broiler facilities. This will be interpreted as immediate family living in the same household.

Get Ready for the 2012 Poultry Institute for Youth

The 2012 Poultry Institute for Youth will be held June 17-19, 2012 in College Station, TX. The Institute is an over-night enrichment camp for students who are interested in pursuing a bachelor's degree in Poultry Science or just interested in the poultry industry in general. Students will attend minilectures taught by our own Texas A&M University staff on topics such as anatomy, embryology, immunology, nutrition and processing. Students will also take field trips to a commercial layer facility and a commercial processing facility. To be eligible students must be entering their junior or senior year of high school during the fall 2012 semester. Austin County 4-H Sizzler Show

The Austin County 4-H Sizzler show is a TJLA sanctioned show open to any 4-H and FFA member from across the state of Texas that is interested in exhibiting steers, halter heifers, lambs or goats. Participants will have the opportunity to participate in two shows and have their animals evaluated by two different judges.

The lamb and goat show will take place on Saturday, May 19th, 2012. Weight and breed cards need to be turned in by 10:00 a.m. with the show to begin once classes are arranged. Entry fees for Ring A will be \$10.00, \$20.00 for Ring B.

The steer show will also take place on Saturday, May 19th, 2012. Weight and breed cards will need to be turned in by 9:00 a.m., with the show to begin once classes are arranged. The Heifer Show will take place on Sunday, May 20th, 2012. Breed registration papers will need to be turned in by 9:00 a.m. with the show beginning once classes are arranged. Entry fees for Ring A will be \$20.00, and \$25.00 for Ring B.

Proceeds from the show go to the Austin County 4-H Parent Leaders Association. We will need help from anyone interested in assisting with the two day event, working in one of the arena's, the 4-H concession stand and assisting with registration. If you would like to help out, please contact the Extension Office.
