Wildflower Identification and Plant Exchange Program



Recipe Corner

Carrot Raisin Salad

Take a bite out of this carrot salad filled with colorful fruits and vegetables. It's an explosion of sweet and crunchy, which is bound to mix-up your taste buds.

Course: Salad Servings: 12



- 4 medium carrots, grated
- 2 medium apples, chopped
- 1 stalk of celery, chopped
- 1 tablespoon of lemon juice
- ½ cup of raisins
- ½ cup low-fat or non-fat vanilla yogurt
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

Instructions:

- 1. Wash carrots, apples, and celery. With a knife or peeler, peel the carrots.
- 2. Chop carrots, apples, and celery and place in a large mixing bowl.
- 3. Add lemon juice, raisins, yogurt, and cinnamon to the bowl of chopped carrots, apples, and celery.
- 4. Stir until evenly coated.
- 5. Chill before serving.
